

HOLIDAY PARTY 2013 A FUN TIME WITH GOOD FRIENDS




15 members came together at Mangia Buffs for the Holiday Party. The food was awesome, company great and setting beautiful.

- For national (LWVUS) positions go to <u>www.lwvor.org</u> (LWV Oregon). At the bottom of the home page on blue strip click on Positions. On that second page look to the right for a list of topics. Find LWV Advocacy and, right under it, LWV of US Positions. Click on that to get Impact on Issues. Scroll down to Public Policy Positions and you will find an 8-page summary of the national positions we will consider.
